Construction Contracting

The construction contracting industry is a multi-faceted field, operating through procurement professionals to ensure that the highest standards are met. The Portland State Construction Contracting certificate offers professionals the tools they need to successfully navigate the construction industry. Students enrolled in the program analyze this dynamic field through case studies, group projects and guest speakers who are experts in the field.

The program is designed for individuals in the public construction contracting arena. This includes procurement and contracting professionals, prime contractors, project managers and engineers. The certificate consists of four courses that cover all aspects of the public contracting process, including competitive bidding, contract administration and project management. Both design and construction contracts will be discussed along with Oregon small business initiatives.

PROGRAM OBJECTIVES

The Construction Contracting certificate exposes students to overall strategy and practical aspects of procurement. Courses are designed to provide participants with the knowledge and skills necessary to contract from acquisition planning through program closeout.

CURRICULUM

To earn the Construction Contracting certificate, complete the following four courses within three years. We recommend you take the courses in the order listed below:

- Introduction to Construction Contracting
- Contracting for Design Services
- Construction Contracting Tools
- Alternative Construction Methods

The courses offered in this program qualify for use in the certification programs for CPSM, CPSD (Insitute forSupply Management) and CPPO, CPPB (Universal Public Procurement Certification Council).
