Come and Celebrate at Columbia Chapter's December General Meeting



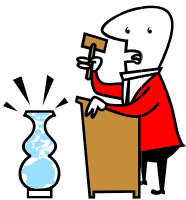
Mark your calendars and be sure to join us for some networking, a little friendly competition, and Chapter business.
